Tania Girard Savoie visual artist uses painting, silkscreen, drawing and printmaking. She lives and works in Quebec City. She holds a Master's degree in visual arts from Laval University in Quebec City and was a professor at the same university. Her creations have been presented solo in several cities of Quebec, as well as in Barcelona in Spain, Scotland, Bulgaria, Brazil, Belgium, France and Germany. She has been selected for a few creative residencies, including Frans Masereel Centrum in Belgium and the International Symposium on Contemporary Art in Baie-Saint-Paul, Quebec. She has won several projects integrating the arts into architecture and is part of collections of works of art, including that of Loto-Québec, that of the National Museum of Fine Arts of Quebec CPOA MNBAQ, that of the city of Quebec and SIMONS. Tania Girard Savoie is currently represented by Galerie Michel Guimont in Quebec City.
